

Sample Itinerary - Day one

Join SEAFARIS at Cairns' Marlin Marina and cruise the coastal journey via False Cape to the world renowned Luggers Pass, a colourful passage through the Great Barrier Reef surrounded by sandy islands and turquoise blue water.

A seafood feast is served at either Norman or Saxon, both reef destinations teeming with marine life. The lavish lunch followed by snorkelling, kayaking, water skiing or a more leisurely pace of cooling off with a swim in the refreshing Australian waters.

The ocean has a habit of igniting the taste buds; your chef will prepare sumptuous canapés and dinner arrangements will be made to suit your mood; a formal dinner party in the main dining room, an alfresco Asian affair at the teppenyaki bar, or a relaxed barbeque on the top deck under the southern stars.

Day 2

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast on the outer Great Barrier Reef before being lowered in the tender and whisked to Escape Reef for an adventure filled day. Is there anyone up for fishing? A catch is guaranteed!

Snorkel with the colourful reef fish and be fascinated by the giant clams. Your gourmet lunch packed by your chef will refuel energy levels. Be thrilled by the talent of your Activities Guide who can pluck a fresh painted crayfish from under a submerged rock for your supper.

Following cocktails at the bar and dinner SEAFARIS will depart Escape Reef and travel to the gorgeous Lizard Island overnight where you will awake in paradise!

Day 3

An invigorating start to the day is a dip in the crystal clear waters of Lizard Island and a chance to exercise ashore by climbing the famous Cook's Look lookout.

There is a spectacular clam garden to snorkel within metres of the yacht in the supremely sheltered bay.

Fill the afternoon with a fishing expedition, beach volleyball or possibly a dive at "snake pit" for the more adventurous.

Indulge in music & cocktails perched on the lounges on the flybridge, or relax in the exterior hydrotherapy spa as the sun sets uninterrupted over the coastline to the west.

Day 4

Arriving early for a leisurely breakfast at Pixie's Pinnacle; you will be enchanted by the variety of hard and soft corals, sea ferns, masses of tropical fish life, huge pelagic, manta rays and the occasional whale.

SEAFARIS will cruise to Dynamite Pass for lunch and in the afternoon guests can snorkel at the world class Cod Hole with the large family of potato cod, giant wrasse and schools of

friendly reef sharks. Swim with these huge creatures and be mesmerised with their gracefulness. An unforgettable excursion!

SEAFARIS will anchor at Number 5 Ribbon Reef for afternoon sundowners and dinner.

After dinner the crew will turn on SEAFARIS' powerful night water lights and you can sit back sipping on your favourite tippie and watch the teeming sea life attracted to the lights.

Day 5

After breakfast SEAFARIS will depart for Snapper Island for a beach barbeque, a little sunbathing or a more adventure packed fishing expedition.

If you are a budding cook, your chef would be delighted to give you a cooking lesson! Expect to hook and cook Spanish Mackerel, Coral Trout, Trevally or Yellow Fin Tuna.

Seeing the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park from the air is a breathtaking experience, thrill away your afternoon on a helicopter excursion (additional package). The water is iridescent blue, the beaches remote and the abundant sea life clearly visible from the chopper.

Wind down the evening with a movie in the cinema, or play a board game in the library.

Day 6

After breakfast in the shelter of Island Point the tender will drop off guests at the tropical seaside village of Port Douglas, for boutique shopping and a leisurely walk.

After lunch the whole family can enjoy an afternoon water skiing, wake boarding, a ride on a sea biscuit, a knee boarding, or all of the above. If this pace is too energetic, the library is filled with beautifully photographed books on Australia and the Great Barrier Reef. There are also a few rare historical novels about life in far north Queensland in the time of Captain Cook.

SEAFARIS will later cruise to the outer Great Barrier Reef for the evening or an afternoon coastal journey to the seaside village of Palm Cove.

Indulge in a stunning candlelit dinner party for the grand finale evening meal.

Day 7

After breakfast and a refreshing early morning swim SEAFARIS leaves the outer Barrier Reef and cruises south, island hopping to Green Island and Fitzroy Island on her way back to Cairns.

Guests will disembark at Marlin Marina with many memories, sated with fresh sumptuous food and the feeling of complete relaxation!
